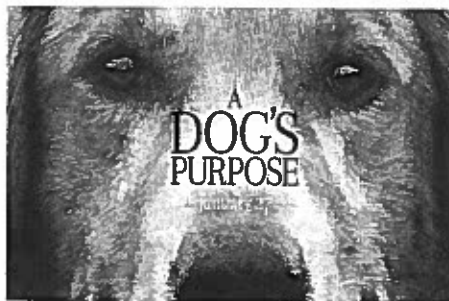
DESPICABLE ME 3

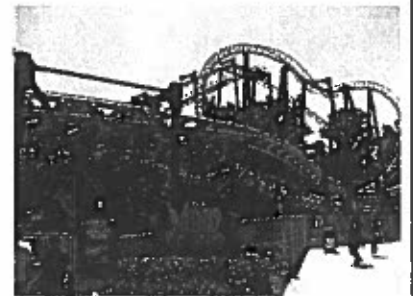

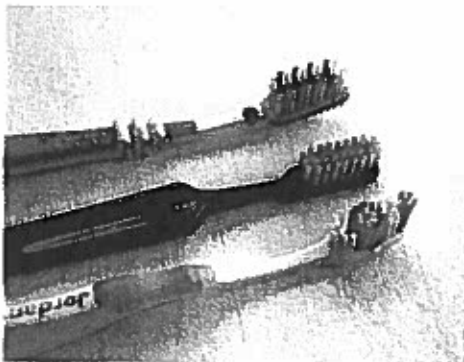
How To Make Paint

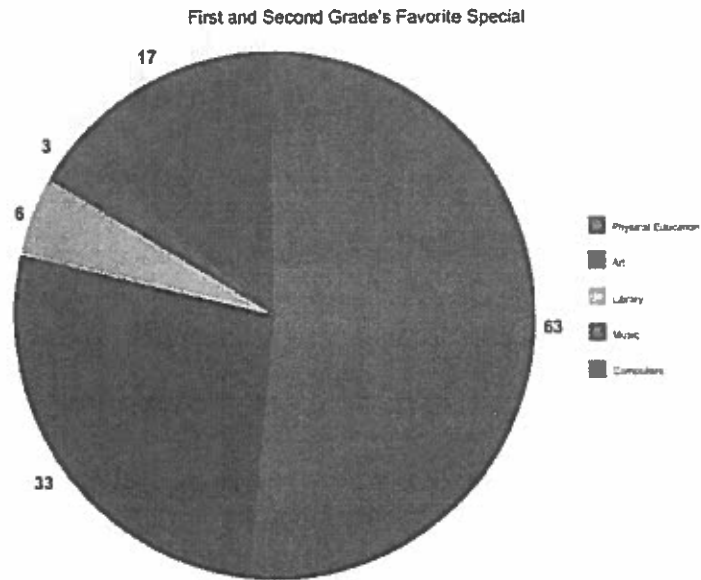
